

When participating at a swim meet, our swimmers are representing the Immanuel Piranhas Swim Club (IMSC). IMSC has a team uniform and swimmers are expected to always wear the appropriate uniform when representing the club. Club uniforms give swimmers a sense of identity and promote team spirit. Uniforms also help spectators identify our swimmers in and out of the water. Swimmers should be proud of the club and display this through wearing of the club uniform.

UNIFORM ITEMS AVAILABLE

The team uniform consists of the following:

- IMSC Swim Cap (new members receive 1 free unnamed cap upon sign-up)
- IMSC Named Caps
- IMSC Dome Cap
- Official Club Polo Shirt
- State Team Singlet
- Cap / Bucket Hat / Beanie
- Hoodie – Zip
- Hoodie Jumper
- Shorts / Tracksuit Pants
- Adult Navy / White Polo
- Adult Puffer Jacket

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE AND NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Swimmers are to wear the Official Club Polo Shirt and IMSC swimming caps (preferably named). If a special team T-shirt has been produced (e.g. for Nationals), this may be worn at agreed times.

Note: Only the Official Club Polo Shirt is to be worn at all medal or award presentations.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR OTHER SWIM MEETS

Any suitable combination of the IMSC uniform may be worn at these meets but are not part of the official IMSC uniform.

ORDERING

The Official Club Polo will be available to order on a quarterly basis as advised by the Uniform Officer on our Facebook closed group page.

Limited stock of unnamed IMSC swimming caps is available from the Uniform Officer, however named caps are ordered on an ad-hoc basis (generally around State or National Championships time).
